Overall we see this development as being atrocious on many fronts.

- Height controls have not been met, therefore partly over-shadow the scarce public open space in the nearby park.
- 2. Separation and setback restrictions have not been adhered to
- 3. The internal amenity of the apartments is far from desirable with token lighting into most bedrooms.
- 4. Overall not fitting with the Sturt street

Should this proposal proceed it would be another unfortunate example of a development not fitting with the streetscape and cultural hub of the cultural spine of the Arts precinct. This development can only be described as a gross overdevelopment.
